Scripture reflection for: The Nativity of the Lord: Dec. 24th/25th.

As we gather here at Christmas time, we can imagine the people of Isaiah’s time, the people who walked in darkness, who dwelt in the land of gloom. But, Isaiah prophesies, they have seen a great light, a light of abundant joy and great rejoicing, a light not unlike the glory of the Lord shining among the shepherds on that first Christmas Eve. For a child is born to us, with every wonderful title that can be imagined: Wonder-Counselor, God-Hero, Father Forever, Prince of Peace, Savior of the World. The light has conquered the darkness.



Scripture reflection for: Holy family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph: Dec. 31st

The feast of the Holy Family has a choice of readings. Sirach and Saint Paul’s Letter to the Colossians concentrate on the family and our calling to treat each other as believers in the Lord and as Christians. The alternative readings about Sarah and Abraham tell of God fulfilling the promise to Abraham that he would have descendants as numerous as the stars in the sky. The Gospel then portrays the devotion of Mary and Joseph, traveling to Jerusalem to present Jesus to God.



Scripture reflection for: Mary, Mother of God: Jan. 1st, 2018

(This is a Holy Day of Obligation)

Today’s readings emphasize the intimacy of God: the blessing the Lord provided for the Israelites, the use of the intimate term Abba to address God, Mary carrying the Son of God in her womb. Mary gives us a model we can all follow, from her obedience and willingness to bear God’s Son to the way she took what she was told about her child and treasured it in her heart.



Scripture reflection for: The Epiphany of the Lord: Jan. 7th, 2018

Today’s readings reflect the joy of today’s event—the Epiphany of the Lord. Isaiah sings of the promise of post-exilic Jerusalem, receiving people and treasures from all nations. The author of Ephesians proclaims that in Christ Jesus we are all members of the same body, that Jew and Gentile alike have received the promise of salvation. The faraway magi in Matthew follow the star to Bethlehem and pay homage to the newborn king.



Baptism of the Lord: Monday, January 8th, 2018

(This is not a Holy Day of Obligation)

The Baptism of the Lord is when we hear John the Baptist preach “The One who is more powerful than I is coming after me, I am not worthy to stoop down and untie the thong of His sandal.” John said: “ I baptize you with water: but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.”
