22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time: September 3rd

Jeremiah in today's first reading shows us what it means to truly belong to God. He cannot suppress the message that God has planted within him. As we hear God's holy word today, listen for the message God has planted within you. How will it burn within your heart, and how will you express it in the world?

23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time: September 10th

Our first reading and Gospel today give us a model to follow when differences arise among us. The way to follow this model is to love one another, as Paul exhorts us to do in the second reading. Yet listen for Jesus' advice for how to deal with someone who is intransigent: "treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector." How did Jesus treat them? What does that mean for you?

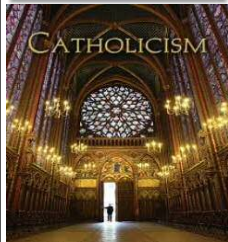
